### 7.3 Institutional Distinctiveness 2023-24

This college was established in 1994 as an institution of higher learning at Joginder Nagar, a subdivision of Mandi district in Himachal Pradesh. The institution offers Arts, Commerce, and Science streams, along with professional courses like BBA and BCA, and postgraduate programs in English and Economics. It also runs an IGNOU centre catering to the educational needs of working individuals.

Institutional distinctiveness plays an important role in the overall growth and development of any educational institution. Rajiv Gandhi Memorial Government College, Joginder Nagar strives to function in a unique, innovative, and distinctive manner compared to other institutions and attempts to reflect this distinctiveness in its work.

A majority of students come from rural backgrounds, and girls outnumber boys. Although many belong to economically weaker sections, they possess significant talent, knowledge, and humility. Faculty members identify and nurture their abilities. The institution's primary objective is to bring more girl students into the mainstream of higher education, contributing to their personal growth and the progress of their families.

As per the mission of the institution, students are provided exposure through participation in curricular, co-curricular, cultural, sports, extension, and social activities. Platforms such as NSS, Rover and Rangers provide opportunities to develop academic, professional, cultural, and social awareness, as well as responsiveness and leadership qualities.

The institution regularly organizes women empowerment programs to build confidence among female students. Prominent women personalities are invited for training, guidance, and interaction on various issues. Health-related seminars, workshops, and medical check-up camps are also conducted in collaboration with government hospitals to address health concerns.

Special initiatives have been taken to enroll more girls in NSS, Rover and Rangers, and NCC. As a result, many students have secured positions in sectors such as the Himachal Pradesh Police, Education Department, Health Department, Forest Department, Railways, and Banking. Many students also receive training from local sports academies and are selected for the Indian Army and paramilitary forces.

The Department of Physical Education provides opportunities for participation in various sports, including Kho-Kho, Badminton, Volleyball, Handball, Basketball, Boxing, Football, Weightlifting, Cross-country, and Athletics.

The Cultural Committee encourages participation in university and state-level cultural competitions.

Another unique feature of the institution is its strong culture of social responsibility. Students, along with staff members, actively participate in blood donation camps organized in collaboration with the Red Cross Society and Civil Hospital Joginder Nagar.

Students maintain respectful relationships with teachers, mentors, and non-teaching staff. The mentor-mentee system is strong, fostering a supportive and healthy academic environment.

## 3. New Library reading room with a seating capacity for one hundred students.

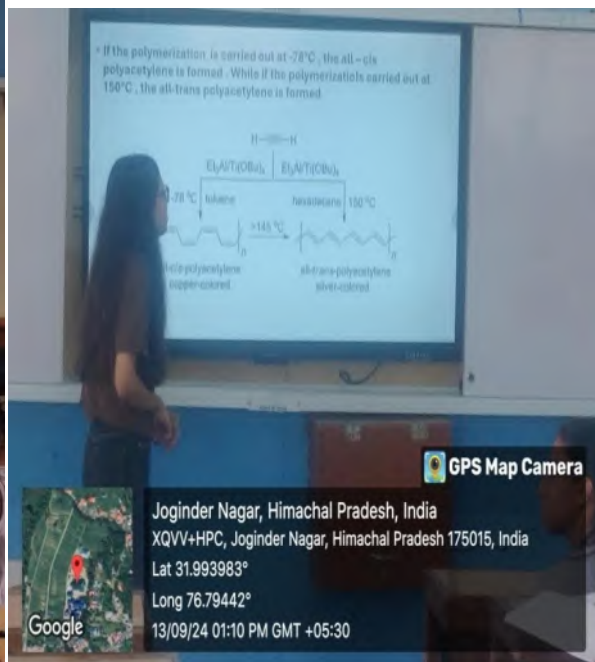
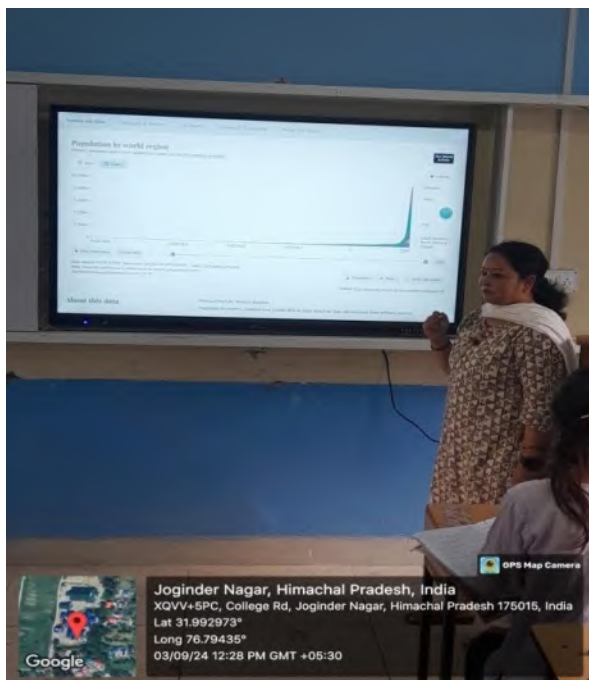
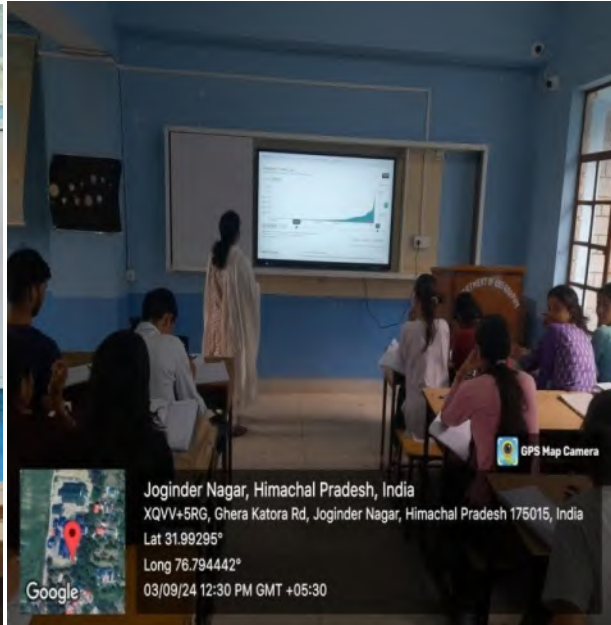
