










Meeting - I

⇒ Various points regarding the MoU with RISM, Joginder Nagar have been finalized.








Meeting 208-04-2024


The college IOAC met on 8th April 2024 at the Principal's office. The following agenda items were addressed upon.

⇒ Book banks have been established by departments of English, Economics, Chemistry, Political Science & Hindi. The meritorious and needy students can get books from there.


⇒ Letter has been written to higher authorities seeking permission to start Post Graduate Programmes in Botany, Zoology, Mathematics, Hindi

Meeting 3 Session - 2023-24
04-05-2024

The college IOAC convened on May 4th, 2024 at the Principal's office, presided over by the esteemed Principal. The primary objective of the gathering was to solicit innovative suggestions from the faculty members for the upcoming 2024-25 academic session. Following points were discussed:

1. Commencing induction programmes for new students to familiarize them with a variety of courses offered by the college.
2. Arranging a one week training programme for laboratory attendants from neighbouring schools and colleges.
3. Establishing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with CSIR and other educational institutions to enhance students' subject knowledge and practical skills through varied techniques.
4. Scheduled a lecture by Dr. Bipal Midha, a freelancer on 7th May, 2024, focussing on "Teacher Leadership and Student Engagement".
5. Formulating an Institutional Development Programme Plan emphasising on

the changes and innovations to be incorporated for the next 2-3 years.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

1. Starting from the academic session 2024-25, all teachers have been directed to conduct induction programmes for new students.
2. Due to the majority of the staff being engaged in election duties, it was not possible to organize a one-week training program; hence, it was decided to schedule the program post-elections.
3. An MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) has been signed between R.G.M Gunt College, Joginder Nagar and Prajapita Brahmkumaris Ishwariya Vishwavidyalaya (PPBKIV) for enthusing moral values among the students and teachers.
4. On 7th May, 2024, a regional seminar was held in conference room where approximately 35 guests including teachers and students, participated in two sessions. The first session focused on student leadership, while the second session centered on research culture. Dr. Gopal Mishra, the resource person, delivered detailed presentations on both topics. Each session was followed by a Q/A Q&A segment that saw active participation from attendees.

5. Responsibilities for drafting the Institutional Development Plan will be allocated to all teachers upon their return from election duties.

6. An Institute Innovation Council has been established, led by Prof. Kaumudi and members from the faculty.
