

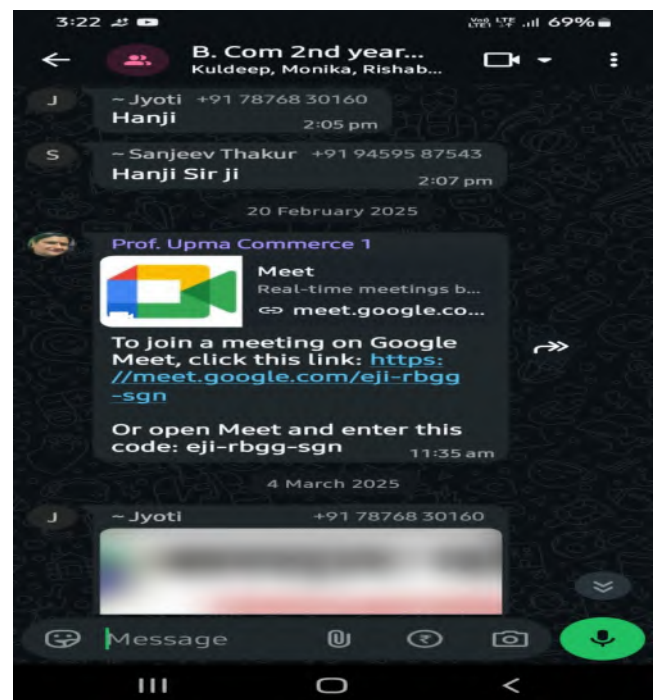
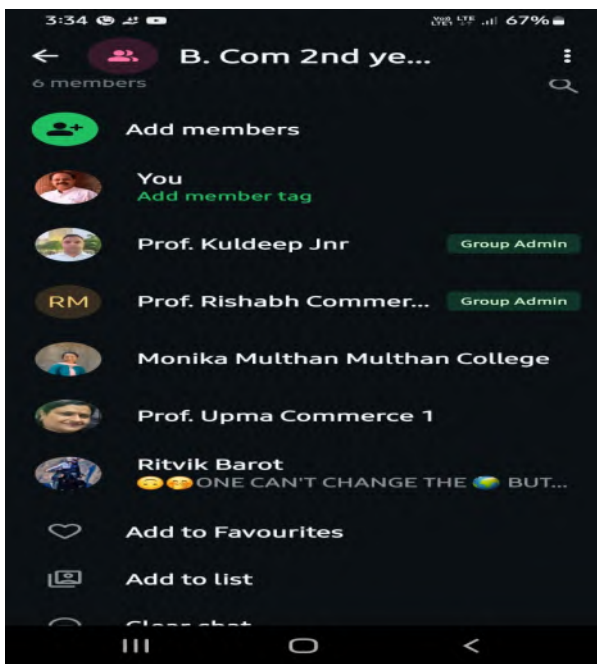

## Function of College Clusters

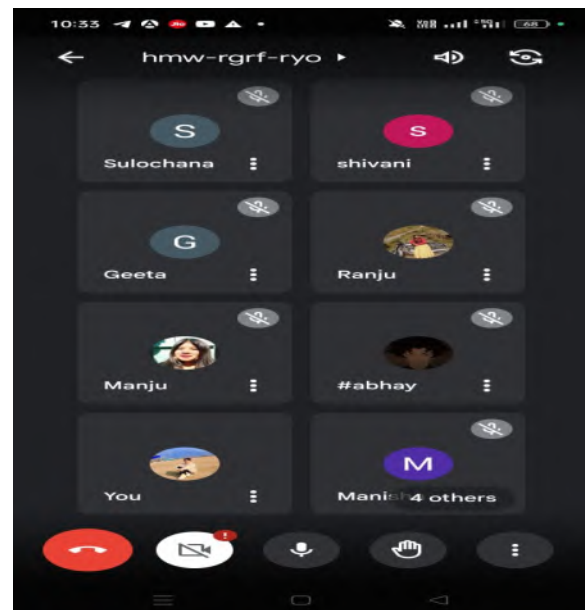
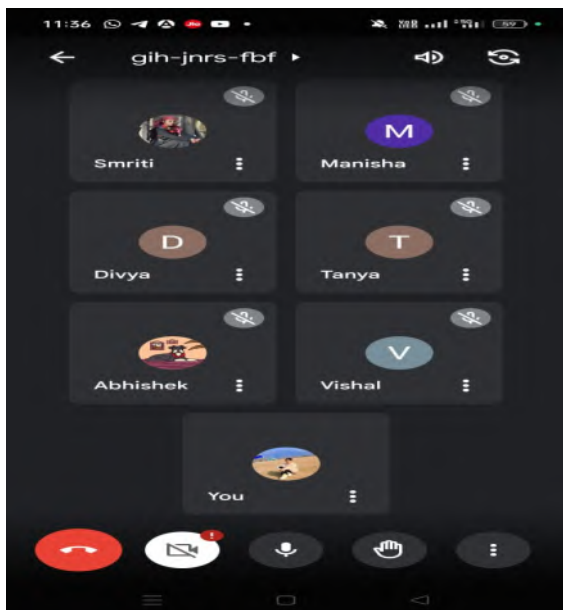
1. Faculty sharing and teaching / interaction through virtual class rooms among cluster colleges for atleast 3 months.
